
The Mighty Muscle



Have you ever looked at your muscles in the mirror? You might have flexed your arm to see your bicep muscles or stood on tiptoe to see the muscles in your calf. These muscles are strong. One of your strongest muscles, however, is one you can't see. It is your heart! Even though it is only about the size of your fist, it is mighty.

Think about it. Your heart never stops. Try holding a rubber ball and squeezing it in your hand over and over. How many times can you squeeze it before your arm gets tired? Your arm muscles are strong, but they need to rest. Your heart doesn't. Even when you are sleeping, it keeps right on working. It beats 100,000 times a day! That's 40 million times a year! Over your lifetime, your heart beats at least 2 billion times! Just like any other healthy muscle, the more you use it, the stronger it gets.

Your heart is extremely important. It pumps blood throughout your body and back to your heart again. The blood travels around your body through a system of tubes called blood vessels. Blood vessels include arteries, veins, and capillaries. This is known as your circulatory system, because

- Put a blue ice cube at one end of the container.
- Add 3 drops of red food coloring to the other end of the container.
- Watch carefully and write down everything you see.

Conclusion:

You should have noticed that the blue ice cube—because it was colder—sank. It represented a cold air mass. The red water—because it was warmer—rose. It represented a warm air mass. This is the same principle you learned about earlier in Experiment #1, when you discovered that temperature causes air to move in different ways.

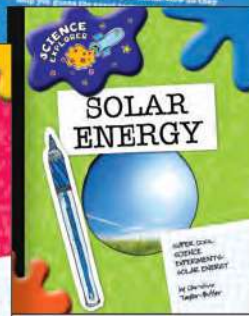
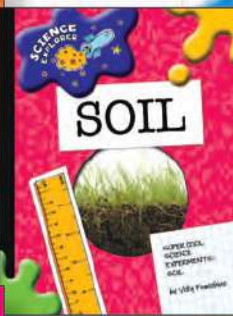
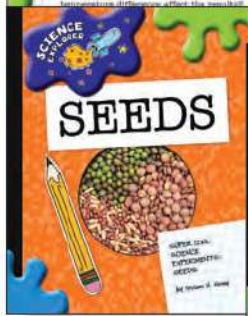
A thunderstorm forms when warm air is forced to rise quickly because a cold front moves in underneath it. Thanks to your experiment, you have seen parts of the process that leads up to a thunderstorm. You also proved your hypothesis—cold air masses do flow beneath warm air masses.

Now repeat the experiment using hot water instead of lukewarm water. Does a greater temperature difference affect the results?

Did you know? A thermometer works the same way. It has a narrow tube filled with liquid. When the temperature goes up, the liquid expands and rises in the tube. When the temperature goes down, the liquid contracts and falls in the tube.

MAKE A THAI KITE

When people in Thailand make kites, some use for flying and some use for decoration. Try this activity to create a kite that can decorate your room.

MATERIALS:

- Long rectangular piece of watercolor paper
- glue
- crayons
- Newspaper
- White glue
- Paintbrushes
- scissors
- ribbon
- Fabric scraps

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Lay the watercolor paper flat, fold the top two corners about one-quarter of the way down. Then fold the bottom two corners about three-quarters down. This should create a long diamond shape like the frame and draw the kite to draw.

➔ Most kites come in all sorts of incredible shapes.

Many Muslims go to a mosque for their daily prayers. They line up to pray behind an imam, who leads them in prayer.

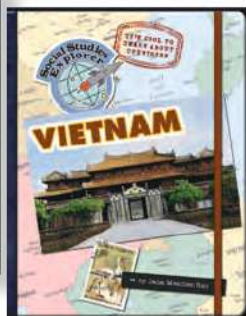
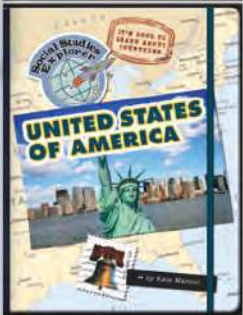
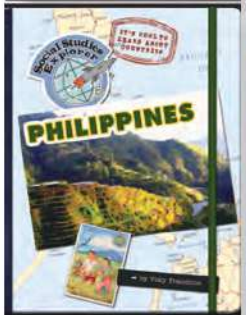
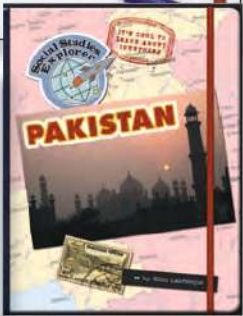
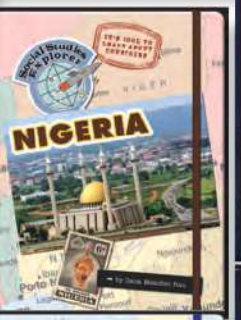

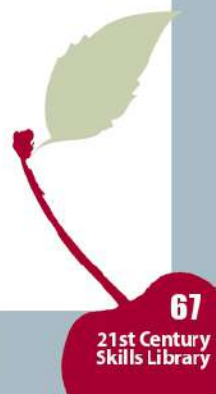
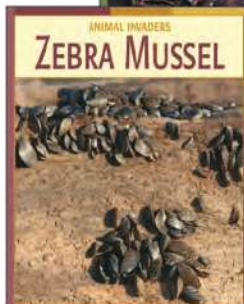
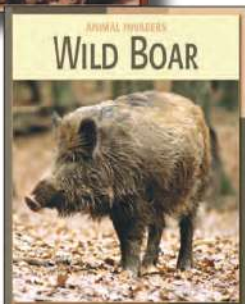
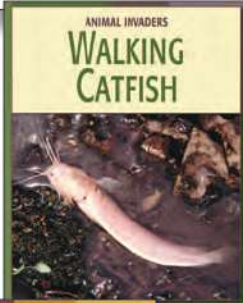
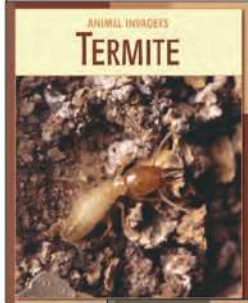
Like other beetles, its body has three main parts—the head, thorax, and abdomen. The small head has two large black or copper-colored eyes. On the thorax are three pairs of legs and two pairs of wings. The outer wings are a bright, metallic green. The inner wings beneath these are more delicate.

When the wings are spread, you can see a shiny, reddish-purple abdomen. Adults are about 0.3 to 0.6 inch (0.8 to 1.4 centimeters) in length.

The emerald ash borer spends most of its life just beneath the bark of the ash.
